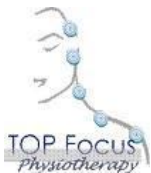

Kings Langley Hockey Club 2009/2010 Annual Report

2010 has seen KLHC, last year's "new kids on the block" consolidate its position in the sporting landscape. A new uniform was introduced, program schedules refined, team and committee numbers increased and a focus placed on improving skills within the club. Two successful grant applications, one through the Department of Sport and Recreation, and the other through the Department of Family and Community Services will ensure KLHC is able to fund further club development programs and education in 2011. Both activities being seen as essential to KLHC's future.

The deterioration of the surface at Pearce Reserve is of significant concern. In consultation with Council and the Pearce Reserve Park Committee KLHC will relocate to Cavanagh Reserve for the 2011 season. Negotiations however continue with these parties regarding the securing of funding to not only repair the surface at Pearce Reserve but also include a number of modifications that will make the facility much more hockey friendly.

Community, business and government continue their support for KLHC as evidenced through sponsorship, donations, grants, newspaper coverage and more recently Council's Synthetic Hockey Field Feasibility Study which recommended that "Council support the development of hockey...."

On a sad note we say farewell to the Graves Family who have moved to Maitland. Maryann, Matthew, BJ, Tim, Johnny and Ashleigh have been an integral part of the club. Their 'can do' attitude, commitment to coaching, committee work, umpiring and play will be missed.

Junior Competition

KLHC fielded an U11, U13 and U15 team in the NAJHA Competition, 1 up from last year. As with last year there were many players new to hockey, some to winter sport, and again it was hoped that players would learn a bit about the game, learn a few skills and enjoy the season.



Our U13's with the athleticism of Nathan, experience and skill of Chris and Patrick and energy and enthusiasm of the entire team combined well earning a semi-final spot and finishing 4th in B Division.

Our U15's, predominately last year's U13 B Joint Premiers moved up a level into the U15 B comp. and were completely overwhelmed and outclassed at the start of the season. With good coaching and plenty of encouragement however the players improved their skills and team work finishing the season with a win against ND's.



Our U11's, last year's C Grade wooden spooners also showed much improved skills and teamwork during the 2010 season. So much so that they accounted for Baulkham Hills in the U11C Grand Final winning 1 - nil.

The performance from all players is to be applauded. All demonstrated commitment, enthusiasm and good sportsmanship through the season. This behaviour both reflects positively on KLHC and provides a happy and supportive environment for all club members. Well Done. We hope to see you back next year.
