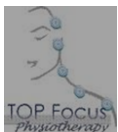

CAVANAGH UPDATE

The new surface is down which is great. As mentioned in the last newsletter there is work needed on the fencing – we are in discussions with Council regarding this. Hopefully there will be some short term repairs and a longer term solution in the offing. In the interim a big thanks goes to Roger who has spent some time recently securing metal rails to the bottom of the fence running along the creek side of the courts.

There are still only 2 of 4 lights working. Council has advised that the trouble has been traced back to wiring located under the new surface. No, they won't be digging up the surface to fix the problem. They will instead be installing new light posts and new wiring to fix the problem. It is expected that the work will be completed in 4 to 6 weeks' time.

As usual the amenities building needs a good clean before the start of the winter season. It would be appreciated if parents could lend a hand with this on Tuesday and Wednesday evening.
